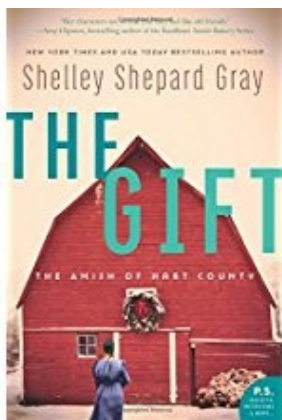
Christian Fiction & Book Club Reads
